MISSION STATEMENT

To transform the lives of people in need, those thought to be "unreachable", men caught in destructive cycle of criminal behavior, domestic violence, homelessness and the many faces of addiction. Where they can find hope, compassion and guidance through the teachings of Jesus Christ as outlined in the Bible.

PROGRAM RULES AND GUIDELINES

Before accepting any legally adult-aged men into our residency program, we meet with and interview them to explain the Christ Like Service's rules and guidelines. For our part, we explain our support services and expectations; for their part, applicants need to demonstrate a commitment to change to get clean and stay sober and out of incarceration, growing in love and wisdom and fear of the Lord. Our ultimate goal is to bring men back home and into the body of Christ.
Christ Like Services home guidelines reflect our ministry's core values:
We believe that every man, regardless of his past, can be redeemed. We believe that a personal relationship with Jesus Christ is essential to each man's recovery.
We believe that success is possible when a man surrenders to Christ and accepts support:

SURRENDER > SUPPORT > SUCCESS.

We believe that when a man becomes healthy in all respects spiritual, emotional, and physical only then will he become successful.
We believe that the most effective mentoring comes from men who have themselves broken the chains of addiction, incarceration, violence, homelessness, and toxic lifestyles.
We also believe that we're all the same in relationship in the body of Christ but different in function.
On this basis, we assign different duties and responsibilities to Christ Like Service men. Before God, all Christ Like Men stand as equals to the staff members placed above them. But, as Christ Like Service staff are assigned different functions, so must the men placed under their guidance show respect to the staff and obey Christ Like Services house rules. As Scripture tells us:
The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. (1Corinthians 12.12)
The eye cannot say to the hand, I don't need you, and the head cannot say to the feet, I don't need you.

Now you are the body of Christ and each one of you is a part of it. (1 Corinthians 12.27)

Men eligible for acceptance into Christ Like Services residency programs will abide by the following general rules:

We will be guided in our relationships by (1 Corinthians 12:12-27): though of one body in Christ, we are different in functions.
We will give superior service and do everything with excellence.
We will treat everyone with dignity and respect.
We will support each man's unique gifts and potential. We will not complain.
We will strive always to be a part of the solution, not the problem.

HOUSE RULES AND GUIDELINES

Given the lack of structure most applicants have experienced throughout their lives, Christ Like Services residence programs present a carefully planned and structured schedule. In order to maintain a safe and sober Christian living environment for men in our residences, the following house rules and guidelines shall be followed:

This is a clean and sober facility- drug and alcohol use is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this rule will be cause for immediate discharge. This is non-negotiable.

1. Upon admittance, residents must notify Chris Like Services of all medications and of changes to any medications during residency. Each resident must have an emergency form on file with Christ Like Services and have a photograph taken and placed in her file. No narcotic-based pain medications are allowed at any time, ever. All medication will be kept in lock box with house manager and distributed daily.

2. Each new resident must pass a 30-day probationary period and observe a strict 9:00 p.m. curfew. No outside visitors are allowed during a resident's 30-day probation.

3. All residents must attend a minimum of (3) 12-step meeting per week. Meeting attendance sheets must be turned in by Friday, 12p.m. Failure to attend required meetings may result in denial of off-site passes and resident will provide a two-page essay on the importance of accountability. All residents must have a sponsor/mentor within (30) days of admittance. All residents may have only (1) sponsor. Sponsors must have at least (1) year clean and worked the 12 steps of their fellowship with a sponsor. A sponsor may visit his sponsee any day between 8 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. when there are no scheduled program functions. Exceptions may be made by C.L.S. staff or board only. Please have sponsors sign-in/out on the visitor's log.

4. Upon completing the 30-day probationary period, resident's house curfew will be 10:00 p.m. unless prior permissions is requested and approved from house manager and board.

5. Residents will be showered, dressed and ready for breakfast by 6:00 a.m.

6. Breakfast begins promptly at 6:05 a.m. The kitchen is to be cleaned and all dishes done in proper locations. Residents are responsible for the purchase and preparation of their own snacks and meals. Label your food and drinks. Remember: **If it's not yours, do not eat or drink it.**
7. Bible study begins at 7:00 a.m. Departure times will vary depending on commute.
8. If not employed residents will prepare for their morning job search, being ready to board the city bus or morning transportation by first departure. If employed residents will provide the house manager with their job schedule and how they are being transported.
9. Lights out in all rooms at 10:00 p.m.
10. Each resident is responsible for checking the posted weekly schedule noting any changes.
11. There is a zero tolerance towards violence in the house. Disruptive behavior is not tolerated. Any behavior which is deemed by staff to be detrimental to the serenity and recovery of any resident is strictly forbidden. These acts include, but are not limited to verbal threats, sexual harassment, and physical violence, destruction of property and/or intimidation of any manner. Any such acts are grounds for discharge.
12. Drugs, alcohol and/or any other unapproved substance is never permitted on Christ Like Services property or in the possession of any resident. All residents are required to submit to random drug and alcohol screening upon admission and at any time upon demand. Refusal to provide UA, PBT (breathalyzer), or other drug test will result in immediate discharge.
13. Smoking/vaping is permitted in designated areas only. Smoking/vaping is not allowed in any indoor areas or in cars that are transporting for C.L.S. Do not leave cigarettes/e-cigarettes unattended. Dispose of your ash and butts in the disposal cans/ashtrays provided. Violation of this rule may result in immediate discharge.
14. Residents are not allowed to borrow money from other residents and/or staff. Borrowing or lending money is often an issue that can cause arguments or other problems between residents. It can also create situations of mistrust. Therefore, it is not permitted while living in Christ Like Service home. Any resident caught stealing of anything will be immediately discharged from the house.
15. No dating is allowed while resident in the Christ Like Service program. Relationships with others in the house should reflect a family type relationship. Association with other residents or staff members in a non-family way (romantic, intimate or sexual manner) may be cause for discharge.

16. Visitation: All visitors and guest must be approved to visit by the house manager and C.L.S. board. Visitors and guests are expected to be clean, sober, and courteous. Visitors and guest are only allowed in the home between the hours of 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Guests may not stay overnight. No visitors are allowed in any of the men's bedrooms at any time. You must always stay with your visitor. NO OVERNIGHT GUEST.
17. Residents are expected to keep the house clean, neat and safe. A list of chores will be posted weekly. Sign up is Sunday morning for chores if you don't sign up a chore will be assigned to you. Residents are expected to complete their assigned chore daily. The inability to complete a chore must be discussed with the house manager in advance, if possible, so that proper arrangements can be made. Repeated inability to participate in chores may be grounds for dismissal. The house manager will determine a fair distribution of household chores.
18. House meetings will be held weekly, and all men are expected to attend. No phone allowed during meetings.
19. Residents may apply for food stamps (Cal Fresh). Christ Like Service will provide a letter on each resident's behalf.
20. Out of respect for their fellows, residents are expected to treat others personal space, privacy, and belongings as they would want their own to be treated. Neither Chris Like Services, board members nor any resident in the house is responsible for any missing of items, for this reason, Christ Like Service residents are advised not to bring anything of real sentimental value into the house.
21. All residents are expected to adhere to the conditions of any court-ordered supervision (ISP, probation, drug court, etc.) in addition to Christ Like Service house guidelines.
22. Given that Christ Like Services is a Christian ministry, all residents are required to attend Sunday church services, Bible studies and house devotionals. Some homework assignments may be required.
23. Each resident will meet with the house manager or board member weekly, day to be determined by manager or board.
24. Each resident is always to maintain a neat and clean appearance. This includes but is not limited to personal hygiene and modest appearance.
25. All speech and conduct will be that which manifests Christian love, compassion and consideration for others. This means no fighting, cursing, talking back, glorifying your past or disrespectful conduct. Our freedom should never offend the freedom of others in Christ.

26. You should always help conserve around the house in order to be good stewards of what God has blessed us with. Turn off lights when not in room, make sure water is turned off. Thermostat should be set at 67 degrees in winter months and 80 degrees in summer months.
27. All belongings and persons may be searched upon entering the program or any time a resident enters or exits the house. This helps to protect against unauthorized substance or anything else which might be harmful to our resident's spiritual, emotional, and/or physical well-being. The safety and well-being of every resident is a priority and we believe that no one willfully wants to jeopardize another's commitment.
28. Guidelines for communication and/or visits for those residents who are married will be made on individual basis and approved by the C.L.S. Men's board.
29. Bathrooms are to be cleaned daily. A rotation schedule will be posted. Do not hang anything on doors and furniture, in showers or wall fixtures. Be considerate of roommates and others.
30. Reasonable noise levels are always to be maintained. No yelling, screaming or excessively loud music/T.V. use should be at minimal sound levels. When playing music in common areas, the type of music should be generally acceptable by others and not excessively loud. When playing music in the room, the music must be acceptable by everyone in the room and played at a minimal sound level.
31. TV use is allowed between 6-10 p.m., Mon-Fri. Special schedules may apply during weekends or special events/occasions.
32. Common areas (living room, dining room) should always be kept neat and clean. Do not move or rearrange any furniture in the common areas or dorms without staff approval. Do not bring in any decor or knick knacks for main living areas. All personal items should be kept in your living space.
33. Laundry hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Do not leave laundry unattended and be prompt in removing your clothes from the washer as soon as it is finished. When hanging clothes on the clothesline, be sure to remove once they are dried to make room for others. No laundry is to be done during any house meetings. A laundry schedule sign-up sheet will be used as needed.
34. Personal items left by discharged residents will be held in the office for maximum of (7) days then donated to a local thrift store. Residents are responsible for making arrangements with staff in advance for the pick-up of their person belongings.
35. Good relations are to be maintained with our neighbors Please conduct yourself accordingly and familiarize yourself with property boundaries. Any potential disputes should be immediately reported to staff. Do not enter the neighbor's property.

36. If an issue arises that is not addressed here, or in emergency posts, do not assume you know the answer. ASK house manager or board first before acting.

37. The first Saturday of the month is general housecleaning from 8 a.m. until completed (or at designated time). General housecleaning is mandatory for all residents unless prior arrangements have been approved by staff. Do not make plans or pass requests during these hours.

Program fee for residency is \$500.00 per month. A \$100.00 security/damage deposit will be due by the 15th of the first month. Fees are due by the 1st of each month. Bounced checks must be paid in full immediately (in cash or money order) with any penalty costs to the house reimbursed. A minimum of (1) week notice must be given before moving out.
